ADB Environmental Categorization

Category "A" Projects: Projects having severe environmental impacts. An EIA is required

Category "B" Projects: Projects having some adverse environmental impacts. An IEE is required in order to determine whether an EIA also needs to be done. If not, then the IEE is the final environment document.

Category "C" Projects: Projects that have no environmental impacts. No IEE or EIA is required but environmental considerations are still reviewed.

Category "FI" Projects: Projects involving a financial intermediary or equity investment. The financial intermediary will apply an environmental management system if environmental impacts are expected.
